BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

**A RESOLUTION ORDERING A PROPOSED MEASURE
ESTABLISHING A PESCADERO MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL
TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS AT
THE NOVEMBER 3, 1992 ELECTION AND PROVIDING
FOR INITIAL ELECTION OF COUNCILMEMBERS**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code section 31010, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 56280 on July 7, 1992, establishing a municipal advisory council for the unincorporated areas of Pescadero, Loma Mar, South Coast, and Butano to be known as the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council, subject to the approval of the voters in those areas at a special election to be held in November 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors determines that the persons residing in the Pescadero area should be presented with a measure asking whether a Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council should be established and be presented with an initial election of the councilmembers:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby submits the proposed measure set forth in section 4(f) to the registered voters who reside in the unincorporated areas of Pescadero, Loma Mar, South Coast, and Butano, the precinct number of those voting areas being precinct number 356001.
2. The Board of Supervisors further submits to those registered voters the initial

above described precinct area a sample ballot and a voter's pamphlet containing the complete text of the proposed measure and a list of the candidates for the Council membership.

(d) The County Clerk shall establish election precincts, designate the polling places, and provide election officers for each precinct at the November 3, 1992 election in accordance with the election laws of the State of California.

(d) The election on the proposed measure and the candidacy for council membership shall be consolidated with any and all other elections to be held on November 3, 1992.

(f) The following measure for the establishment of a Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council shall be submitted to the electorate on November 3, 1992:

Shall a thirteen (13) member Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council be established to advise the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works and planning which affect the unincorporated areas of Pescadero, Loma Mar, South Coast, and Butano.

(g) A list of candidates who have filed the necessary nomination papers and satisfied all other requirements shall be submitted to the electorate on November 3, 1992 for the thirteen (13) members of the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council.
