**For Immediate Release - Notice of Vacancy**

## **Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee**

President of the Board of Supervisors Warren Slocum announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee. There are currently two (2) vacancies that will be filled for alternate members. To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of San Mateo County.

This five-member committee advises the Board of Supervisors on funding, projects, programs and policies related to improving and increasing bicycling and walking transportation, primarily within the County's unincorporated communities. Alternate members actively participate in all member discussions, with the distinction that they only vote on matters at meetings when one or more of the five regular members are absent and a quorum is needed. The Committee establishes the time and place of its regular meetings, and meets at least 4 times a year, unless otherwise determined by a majority vote of the Committee.

**Deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, August 14, 2020 at 5 p.m.**
