Public Authority Advisory Committee



President of the Board of Supervisors Don Horsley announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Public Authority Advisory Committee. There is currently one (1) vacancy representing: Member-At-Large. To be eligible, applicant must be a resident of the County of San Mateo. The ideal candidate will possess several of the following attributes:

- A current or former recipient of personal assistance services
- An interest in helping the elderly and persons with disabilities to maintain their independence
- An awareness and knowledge of the In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program and the Public Authority for IHSS
- Informed on issues important to IHSS consumers and providers

The Public Authority Advisory Committee was established to meet and confer with the Public Authority about those aspects of the IHSS Program that relate to home care providers. The Advisory Committee will focus primarily on issues relating to IHSS provider training and the maintenance of the IHSS Provider Registry.

The Public Authority Advisory Committee meets on the 1st Wednesday of every other month at 10:00 AM at the San Mateo Health System, 225 37th Avenue, Room 137, San Mateo.
