Commission on the Status of Women

President of the Board of Supervisors Carole Groom announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Commission on the Status of Women. There are currently four (4) vacancies on the Commission representing any district in San Mateo County. Applicants must reside in San Mateo County.

The Commission on the Status of Women consists of 17 adult and 2 youth members. The current vacancies are for adult members.

The mission of the Commission on the Status of Women is to improve the quality of life for women of all ages in San Mateo County. Through strategic partnerships and collaboration, the commission identifies women's needs, advises the Board of Supervisors, and educates the community on matters concerning women.

The Commission encourages candidates to attend a minimum of one CSW meeting prior to applying; and recommends attending two CSW meetings in total. Attending a CSW meeting will help the candidate understand more about member roles, how meetings are conducted and meet current commissioners.

Meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of the month from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. in Room 101 at 455 County Center, Room 101, Redwood City, CA.
