For Immediate Release - Notice of Vacancy

Parks Commission

President of the Board of Supervisors announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Parks and Recreation Commission. There is currently one (1) vacancy on the Parks and Recreation Commission representing District 1. To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of the County of San Mateo and reside in the District 1 boundaries. District 1 includes the cities of Burlingame, Hillsborough, Millbrae, San Bruno (everything east of Interstate 280 and areas west of 280 and south of Sneath Lane) and South San Francisco (east of Junipero Serra Boulevard and south of Hickey and Hillside Boulevards).
