Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee

President of the Board of Supervisors Carole Groom announced that applications are being accepted for appointment to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee. There is currently one (1) vacancy for an At-Large member. To be eligible, applicants must be a resident of San Mateo County and live in District 1, District 2, District 4, or District 5.

This five-member committee advises the Board of Supervisors on funding, projects, programs and policies related to improving and increasing bicycling and walking transportation.

The Committee establishes the time and place of its regular meetings, and meets at least 4 times a year, unless otherwise determined by a majority vote of the Committee.
